JULY 2009 NEWSLETTER

EBSC Minutes Saturday, June 6, 2009 Time Out Sports Bar (Reported by Robin Harris-Secretary)

- I. Rick Bivins got all members attention and turned over the floor to Don Evers who called the meeting to order.
- II. Don asked if there were any discussion regarding the May minutes. There was no discussion so a motion was made to approve the minutes and the motion carried.
- III. Treasury Report – Don turned the floor over to Edwin to report on our financial situation. Edwin summarized disbursements and receipts. He reported that the Area Party had a profit of \$206.13 and that the golf tournament has brought in excellent returns thus far and is proving to be a great hit. There are still receipts and deposits outstanding from today's golf event. Edwin stated a final detailed report will be given at the July meeting. Edwin concluded his report by stating that our financial situation is excellent. Don Evers asked if there were any questions regarding the Treasurers report and there was no further discussion.
- IV. Committee Reports
 - a. Sunshine Committee – Judy was not available for a report; however, Nancy Pope informed the group that Janice Rhew Thornton had passed away from cancer. Janice and her husband Otis were members of EBSC and were very active with our shag club when the club met at the Dome.
 - b. Membership Committee – David Lutz reported our membership total at 143 with 7 new members for the month of May. He also informed everyone that the raffle tickets are being printed and the prize this year will be \$500 cash rather than a shopping spree at South Point Mall. All members will receive 10 tickets each to sale. The tickets will be mailed out the middle of June. The winner will be drawn at the dance contest.
 - c. Golf Committee – Mike Harris and Don Rust thanked everyone that participated in the golf tournament and gave a special thanks to all of the businesses who helped sponsor the tournament. In addition, they thanked Lake Winds for their support and assistance with the food and preparation of the golf course for the event which included over 100 participants. Mike & Don encouraged our members to see who the

sponsors are on our website and support their businesses and let them know you are a member of Eno Beach Shag Club. Mike Harris made a motion that the club makes our donation to the Ronald McDonald House. Dewey seconded the motion and the motion carried. Edwin stated that he would cut the check.

- d. Dance Contest – Susan Evers reported that 40% of the seats for the dance contest have been sold for a total income of \$3,950. Susan also mentioned that she and Nancy spread the word about the dance contest at the golf tournament and there was some interest in sponsorships. The dance contest is now being advertised to the public and emails will be sent to our sister clubs to promote more interest and sale out the remainder of the seating. Anyone who has not purchased their seats and would like to reserve a seat tonight should see Nancy who has the seating chart.
- v. Other Business
 - a. Don reminded the members that Chigger has received 100 SOS raffle tickets for our club to sale. The cost is \$10.00 per ticket and once we have sold the 100 tickets, our space for Fun Monday's hot dog sales during fall SOS will be free.
 - b. Linda had two sample Coalition shirts that she displayed to the members.  - c. Linda reminded the members of additional events to include the Burlington Luau on June 13th, and the 3-club social on June 21. Gene Pope informed the group that the Richmond Shag Club would be having a Shag contest June 13th as well and they would be there giving a workshop. Don also congratulated Gene & Nancy on their recent first place win at the Grand Nationals in Atlanta for two years running.
 - d. Don Evers mentioned to the group that our raffle, dance contest and Fun Monday hot dog sales are our remaining large events of the year. He asked that the members start thinking about selecting Board Members for 2010. He commented that the current board has had a great year thus far and that he was so grateful for the support and hard work of Linda, Rick, Edwin and Robin. He thanked Don & Mike for putting on a great golf tournament. He also thanked Cheryl Harden and the Area Party committee for their hard work organizing the Area Party making it a great success this year.
- vi. Don opened the floor for any additional business. The motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. Don officially adjourned.

Sam West began dancing at age 9. As a junior shagger he won two National titles with Terri Alberty. Terri's father, the famed shag dancer Shad Alberty, significantly influenced Sam's dancing career.

In 1994, Sam, with his partner Melissa Calabrese, won the Non-Pro National title and became Overall National Shag Champions. He partnered with his sister, Sarah in 1995 and they went on to capture eight Professional Division titles and four Overall titles.

Sam also won the Pro and Overall shag titles in 2001 with Jackie McGee and again in 2006 and 2007 with Jessica McAlhany.

Sam is a six time champion of the Carolina Shag Division of the USA Grand National Dance Championships and a three time US Open Shag Champion. He has also been a member, captain and choreographer for the National Shag Dance Championship Team.

Lisa is accomplished in County Western dance, waltz, east and west coast swing, polka and cha-cha. She competed on the swing and cabaret circuit with Barry Durand. Together they won the 1997 US Open Cabaret Championship and were two-time winners of the American Swing Dance Championship in the Showcase Division.

Together Sam & Lisa have promoted the shag throughout the US and in several foreign countries.

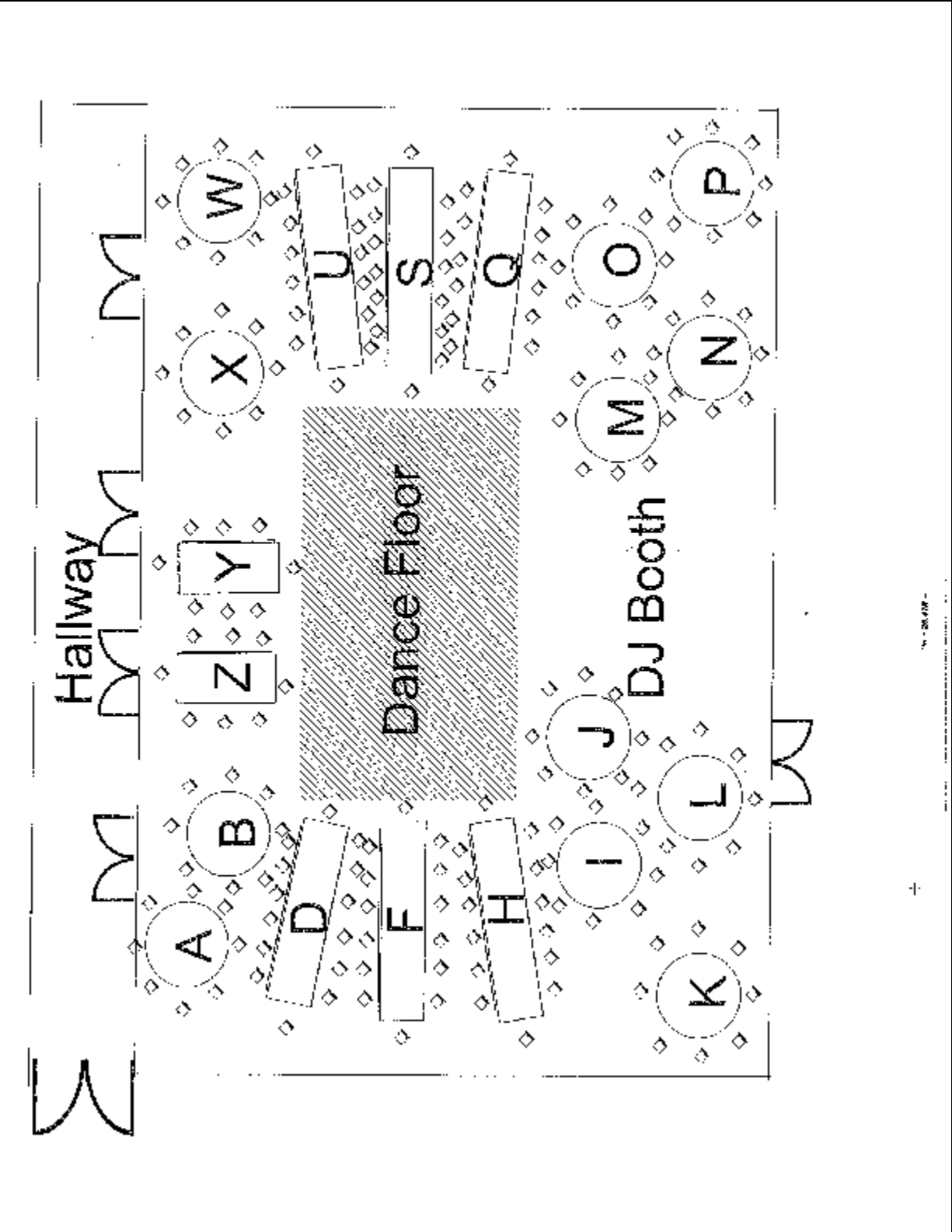
